Subject: Brief Relief and Disposa-John

Regional Board staff has completed an evaluation of the Material Safety Data Sheet and other information you provided to evaluate whether the subject products are suitable for disposal at a Class III landfill. We understand that these materials are designed for use during emergency situations when water supplies are not operable or when restroom facilities are not available.

In accordance with Section 2520 (d)(2) of the California Code of Regulation, Title 23, Division 3, Chapter 15, Discharges of Waste to Land, discharge of semi-solid wastes (wastes containing less than 50% solids) to a class III landfill are prohibited. We are unable to determine whether the products, once they have been used, will contain less than 50% solids. However, it appears that due to the small size of the containers, they will not individually or cumulatively add a significant volume of liquid if disposed of properly to a landfill. Therefore, we do not object to the disposal of the subject materials at any class III landfill accepting non-hazardous waste.
