Choices? There's a restroom right down the hall!

Unfortunately, that's not the case for Field Service and Repair Crews. Most job sites have no facilities at all, and that's usually not a problem, but...when nature calls, the obvious (and recommended) choice is to leave the work site and locate a nearby public



restroom to use. The need for a second choice, however, becomes important in those situations when public facilities are not at all nearby or when the process of job tears down and reset-up is just too time consuming.

When these situations arise, Field Crews now have the choice to use Brief Relief and the Brief Relief Field Lavatory System. Is a single use, disposable urinal bag that contains a unique blend of polymers and enzymes to convert urine into a deodorized gel that's approved for disposal in any waste container? No special handling or disposal is required. Any trash receptacle is fine. When you're stuck on the job and nature calls...use Brief Relief.

In certain job situations, you might need to handle more than simple liquid waste and still be unable to close the site and find a local restroom. In those cases, the Brief Relief Field Lavatory System includes a 5-gallon pail and a soft seat that acts as The Commode, plus the Disposa-John Portable Restroom Kit that contains and treats the waste for safe disposal. Brief Relief is a safe, sanitary and the only choice to take when local facilities are unavailable or inaccessible.
