We have reviewed the information enclosed with your letter and have concluded the products, when used for the intended purpose, meet the definition of "municipal waste" as that term is defined in Section 3.21 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act. As a municipal waste, the used products may be disposed in any permitted municipal solid waste landfill in the State of Illinois.
